25 Years in Old Orchard Road

Where has all the time gone? It doesn't seem possible that the Eastbourne Chiropractic Clinic having been originally in Chiswick Place in the 70's and mid 80's, Hyde Gardens in late 80's and early 90's would find its 'final resting place' at Old Orchard Road in September 1992.

It became obvious during late '91 that with patient numbers and the popularity of Chiropractor increasing we had to find larger premises that could accommodate two full time chiropractors plus other health disciplines as well.

We wanted a fairly central yet quiet location and ideally close to other health professionals. A dear lady and eye specialist, Mary Simpkins (who unfortunately is no longer with us) told me of the ground floor flat at 5 Old Orchard

Road being up for sale. Without hesitation the property was viewed and bought, subject to planning permission. What could be easier I thought? How wrong could I be!!

Plans were submitted via an architect and promptly rejected because it was a solely residential road and also no plans for car parking were submitted. It was therefore pointed out to the planning committee that there was a Dental Surgery next door, a care home opposite to the right, a medical practice opposite to the left and the Magistrate's Court at the end. Hence we appealed and resubmitted plans to include parking for 2 cars at the front.



Once again planning was refused for guess what? Apparently Old Orchard Road was a green road and

having parking space at the front was not in keeping with this. We now began to 'smell a rat' as the dentist next door had parking for 3 cars and the adjacent house at No.7 had parking for 2 cars plus umpteen parking spaces at the Magistrates Court.

A very good friend of mine and retired architect, Clifford Powell, immediately spotted some strange inconsistencies here and having had years of experience dealing with planners in other parts of the South East advised me not to appeal a third time to the local planning committee but to take it to the top ie Department of Environment.(DOE). Cutting a long story short, the inspector from the DOE came down to officiate a hearing

in the Town Hall. Eastbourne's chief planning officer at the time did not appear and sent someone else to represent him. Having heard and read all the information, the inspector threw out all the objections and granted planning permission for Old Orchard Road to be converted from a flat to a Chiropractic Clinic. I'll leave you to decide why planning had previously been refused!

All this of course took months and because of this the flat remained empty and my worst fears were realised when squatters moved in. We eventually managed to evict them thanks to the efforts of the team of workmen who were carrying out the conversion! However not before the rooms were trashed and doors removed and used as firewood and a lovely marble fireplace smashed to pieces. However the team of workmen led by David Cranstone did a fantastic job in completing the work by the end of August and in September, 5 Old Orchard Road officially became Eastbourne Chiropractic Clinic.




Over the ensuing years the clinic became busier and busier and it was great for the Chiropractic profession to see
